

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS KITS

We are collecting emergency preparedness kits to store at our school in the event of an emergency. Please put the bottom half of the second sheet and the items listed below in the resealable bag provided and return it on your child's first day of school.

FORM

Please complete the information on the second page of this letter, fold it with your child's name (**large black print**) showing and place it in the bag with the clothes and photos.

PHOTOGRAPHS

We recommend two photographs of your child's family and pets stored back to back with images showing in the bag provided. The photos are used as a comfort item in the event of an emergency that separates children from family. The emergency photos are in addition to any photos requested by the classroom teacher and will be stored with the emergency supplies.

SNACKS AND JUICE

Please provide two or three nonperishable snack items and two cans (not boxes) of juice that your child enjoys. Please make certain that the expiration dates will be past May 2012 to ensure they will last throughout the school year. Cans of juice are preferable to juice boxes due to storage limitations. An emergency supply of bottled water will be provided by BACNS.

CLOTHING

Emergency clothing should be comfortable and slightly large to allow for growth and layering. Emergency clothing is stored with the emergency supplies and is in addition to any extra clothing provided for daily needs in your child's cubby. We recommend that you label all clothing you bring to school (initials or name in permanent marker on the tag or inside hem). Cotton or sturdy natural fiber is preferred.

Items to pack are as follows:

- 1 long sleeved shirt
- 1 pair of sweatpants (non-denim, pull up, easily washed and dried pants)
- 2 pairs of underwear/diapers/pull-ups
- 2 pair of socks
